

LENTEN ALMSGIVING

Why Do We Give Alms? The foundational call of Christians to charity is a frequent theme of the Gospels. During Lent, we are asked to focus more intently on "almsgiving," which means donating money or goods to the poor and performing other acts of charity. As one of the three pillars of Lenten practice, almsgiving is "a witness to fraternal charity" and "a work of justice pleasing to God." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2462) This LENT St. Gerard has chosen two outreach ministries to support with ALMSGIVING.

CEAP (Community Emergency Assistance Program) & "Friends of the Poor Ministry"

Donations can be placed in the designated plastic boxes located in the gathering space during the Lenten season starting Ash Wednesday.
