A NOTE FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR

My brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus,

At the beginning of the last bulletin, our pastor said, “there are many moving parts that make up a vibrant parish,” and he listed them. I agree. I see that many of us are engaging in current programs and some we are about to start. We are blessed with volunteers who are standing up and willing to lead, to learn, to listen, with loving hearts for St. Gerard. Thanks so much for your commitment as we strive to see God in one another. So, let me share with you what is happening in this coming month of October.

October is the month of the Rosary. During this month, many families are praying this devotion together. Of particular importance, is the feast day of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7. This day remembers a glorious and triumphant victory at the battle of Lepanto in the year 1571. That battle was a most convincing military victory guarding Christian Europe and proved, without a doubt, the great power of the Rosary through the intercession of our Blessed Virgin Mother, Mary.

On a personal note, October is also a special month for me because 30 years ago my siblings and I, along with others, 58 in total, were confined to the bottom of a river boat to escape Vietnam over the south Pacific Ocean. We finally reached Galang Refugee Camp in Indonesia on October 17, 1989. In my pocket at the time, was my rosary. I used it during that horrible journey to pray and place my trust in our Blessed Virgin Mother as we looked to the Northern Star for navigation. The rosary is no longer with me since it was rotted due to the sea water. Praying the rosary has since been a priority for me because of what I had gone through. I firmly believe our Blessed Mother had helped.

Also, October 16 is the Feast Day of Saint Gerard. The Redemptorists helped us build this parish and St. Gerard is named as our patron saint. A patron saint is a saint whose protection and intercession to whom a person, a society, a church, or a place is dedicated. St. Gerard has been blessed and next year is our 50th anniversary - a celebration of half a century! While St. Gerard's feast day is on Wednesday this year, Father John, staff members and myself agreed to move the Feast day to Sunday October 20, where we will join this celebration with other activities already planned for that weekend. Please join us for the celebration. At Mass, we will have a special blessing for women who are pregnant, desiring to become pregnant, also blessing those having difficulties in their pregnancy, and others who have experienced the loss of a child. Please come for a blessing through the intercession of Saint Gerard. And, after the Mass please join the KC pancake breakfast.

Finally, a couple of weeks ago, in our bulletin, I had mentioned an **Anointing of the Sick during the celebration of the 10:30am Holy Mass on the actual Feast day of St. Gerard, October 16, 2019. Lunch will be**

served following the Mass of Anointing. Staff members and council members will serve lunch to all participating parishioners and visitors. Please let us know if you are coming so we have a proper head count so that we may secure additional priest(s) and have enough food for all.

Remember that the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is for those “who, having reached the age of reason, begins to be in danger of death due to sickness or old age.” It gives comfort, peace and courage to the faithful. **The special grace of the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick has as its effects:**

- the uniting of the faithful to the passion of Christ, for their own good and that of the whole Church;
- the strengthening, peace, and courage to endure in a Christian manner the sufferings of illness or old age;
- the forgiveness of sins, if the faithful are not able to obtain it through the sacrament of penance;
- the restoration of health, if it is conducive to the salvation of his/her soul;
- the preparation for passing over to eternal life.

Father John and I desire to respond to any call when one of the faithful in our community needs to be anointed. Please give us a chance to serve you wherever you are to meet God's Mercy.
