

COVID-19 Usher Protocols and Training

Purpose: To ensure safety and security of all Parishioners and guests of the Church of St. Gerard Majella.

Requirements: Ushers must meet all the following requirements

- Be willing to follow specific guidelines as set forward by the Church of St. Gerard Majella
- Be in good health and not exhibiting any signs of COVID-19 infection (see CDC guidelines)
- Must be under the "high-risk" age of 65 as defined by the CDC
- Must be over 18yrs of age unless written Parental Consent is obtained
- Must be willing to sign a liability waiver as provided by the Church of St. Gerard Majella

Time Commitments:

- Please be prepared to come at least 1 hour prior to the start of the Masses
- Please contact the Parish Administrator immediately if you are feeling sick, or are otherwise unable to complete your obligation

PPE Requirements/Social Distancing:

- Gloves, masks, hand-washing stations, sanitizing wipes and hand sanitizer will be provided and must be worn at all times while on campus.
- Please properly dispose of used PPE equipment in a safe manner and launder all personal clothes after serving following safety guidelines as provided by the CDC.

POSITIONS:

Usher Station #1

- Prior to Mass:

- Located outside front entrance.
- o Directing and assisting Parishioners on which entrances to use
- Inform people of social distancing guidelines.
- o Informing all of PPE requirements (masks must be worn at all time)
- If you notice people congregating, politely ask that they observe proper social distancing guidelines.
- o If they do not have masks, ask them to go home to get them.

- During Mass:

- Close and lock *Outside Entrance Doors* 10 minutes after start of Mass
- Open *Outside Exit Doors* 30 minutes after start of Mass
- Prior to end of Mass, set out empty cleaned/sanitized Offertory Basket by door and assist Parishioners in exiting Gathering Space

- After Mass:

- o Ensure that all Parishioners are out of building and perform a quick walkthrough
- Wash hands



Usher Station #2

- Prior to Mass:

- o Located at *Check-In* station inside *Gathering Space*.
- o Take temperatures of people Advise anyone running fever to stay home.
- Inform people of social distancing guidelines.
- o Informing all of PPE requirements.
- If you notice people congregating, politely ask that they observe proper social distancing guidelines.
- o If they do not have masks, ask them to go home to get them.
- Once temperatures are taken, wait until an Usher is available to seat them in the Church.
- Once Main Church is filled, reconfigure Check-In station to send Parishioners to Social
 Hall

- During Mass:

 Monitor *Restrooms*. Only 1 person at a time and CDC informed handwashing is required. Sanitize as needed. Keep doors propped open.

- After Mass:

- Ensure that all Parishioners are out of building and perform a quick walkthrough
- Wash hands

Usher Station #3

- Prior to Mass:

- Located in Main Church/Social Hall.
- Begin seating groups and individuals one party at a time in *Main Church*. Seating order is front first to back last. Handicapped/Wheelchair location in SW rear.
- Begin seating groups and individuals one party at a time in **Social Hall**. Seating order is back first to front last.
- o Inform people of social distancing guidelines.
- o Informing all of PPE requirements.
- o Main Church, keep 3 chairs between groups. Social Hall, keep 4 chairs between groups.
- Once Main Church is filled, notify Usher Station #2 to send people to Social Hall
- o Be sure that only the inside center rear church door is open.

- During Mass:

- Prop open all *Internal Rear Doors*.
- Stay in Main Church/Social Hall and serve as a resource
- At the end of Mass, have all people remain seated
- o In *Main Church*, begin releasing rows for communion beginning with the back first.
- o In *Social Hall*, begin releasing rows for communion beginning with the front first.

- After Mass:

- Ensure that all Parishioners are out of building and perform a quick walkthrough
- Wash hands
