Ken Engel is chair of CHAIM (Children of Holocaust Survivors Association in Minnesota). As a member of the Speakers Bureau of the Jewish Community Relations Council of Minnesota and the Dakotas/Tolerance Minnesota, the JCRC Middle East Speakers Bureau, and other platforms, he's given hundreds of presentations about the Shoah, his parents' experiences during World War II, Israel, Judaism, and related subjects.
