DERBY CAR REGULATIONS:

1. *Pumpkin Derby Cars must include at least 1 real pumpkin. (Feel free to use as many as you like!)*
2. *Pumpkin Derby Cars cannot exceed 18" in width. (Track lanes will be approximately 20" wide.)*
3. *Pumpkin Derby Cars must have at least 3 wheels built in. (Again, feel free to use more!)*
4. *Pumpkin Derby Cars must be released from the top of the ramp. (No pushing allowed!)*
5. *Pumpkin Derby Cars must be powered only by GRAVITY, no motors, batteries, fans, etc. may be used to power the car.*
6. *Other than those listed above, anything goes!!! BE CREATIVE!*

DERBY CATEGORIES:

- ✧ *RAMP RACE: Pumpkin Derby Cars will race 2 at a time down a ramp. The first car to reach the finish line will win the heat. The winner of each individual race will move on to the next round.*
- ✧ *DISTANCE RACE: All Pumpkin Derby Cars will be allowed to race down the ramp and roll as far as possible. The longest run along the track will be the winner!*
- ✧ *BEST IN SHOW: All Pumpkin Derby Cars will be judged for creativity and originality.*
